DANCER CLASS LEVELS: PLACEMENT GUIDELINES

Placement is based on age, experience, technical proficiency, and classroom readiness.

Most dancers will spend 2–3 years in each level.

Unlimited training and/or competition team participation is recommended for dancers pursuing accelerated growth and advanced achievement.

Parent & Me | Ages 2–3: A caregiver-assisted introduction to dance focused on movement exploration, coordination, rhythm, and motor skill development.

Creative Movement/Toddler Tumble | Ages 3–4: Students build coordination, creativity, confidence, and classroom skills through movement, tumbling, and imaginative dance activities.

“Pre” Levels | Ages 5–6: An encouraging introduction to structured dance training, combining foundational technique, musicality, creativity, and classroom discipline. Students may enroll in as many classes as desired.

Acro | Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced: A strength-based tumbling and acrobatics program designed to improve flexibility, control, balance, and trick progression. Intermediate and Advanced levels require approval.

Level 1 | Ages 7–8: Students begin focused technical training while expanding ballet and jazz vocabulary, musicality, and classroom discipline. Two technique classes required.

Level 2 | Ages 9–10: Students develop stronger technical understanding through more complex exercises, detailed corrections, and increased training expectations. Supplemental acro, hip hop, or stretch & strength is encouraged.

Level 3 | Ages 11–12 or DOE: Students demonstrate a solid technical foundation and commitment to focused training. Emphasis is placed on refinement, corrections, artistry, and versatility across styles.

Level 4 | Ages 13+ or DOE: Dance becomes a serious commitment at this level. Students train consistently in multiple styles with an emphasis on technical growth, artistry, performance quality, and discipline.

Level 5 | Ages 15+ or DOE: Advanced dancers demonstrate strong technical proficiency, maturity, and dedication to intensive training and continued artistic development.

Level 6 | Ages 16+ or DOE: Our highest level of training for dancers who exhibit exceptional technique, versatility, professionalism, and commitment across all styles.

Pointe | Level 4+: Available to qualified ballet students by instructor approval only.

Competition Teams: Studio Pulse offers four elite competition teams: Minis, Junior Company, Teen Company, and Senior Company. Placement is by audition or invitation only. Team members demonstrate exceptional commitment, work ethic, teamwork, and passion for performance while attending conventions and competitions throughout the season.

Comp Lab: Additional rotating rehearsal time dedicated to polishing and refining competition choreography.

Street Style Competition Teams: Competitive hip hop crews led by acclaimed Anchorage educators Cherish DeBord and Toby Carrillo. Available for ages 9–adult by audition or approval only.

Open/Community Classes at The Annex:

Additional training opportunities for teens seeking expanded dance experiences and drop-in classes.



CLASS DESCRIPTORS

Toddler Tumbling: Introduces children to foundational movement. Class uses mats and obstacle courses to build balance, coordination, and spatial awareness through guided activities like somersaults, bear crawls, and animal walks. Ages 2.5-5

Parent & Me:

A joyful first dance experience designed to build coordination, balance, musicality, motor skills, and confidence alongside a caregiver. Ages 2-3

Creative Movement:

An engaging introduction to movement, music, coordination, creativity, classroom etiquette, and self-expression. Ages 3-4

Pre-Ballet:

A structured introduction to ballet technique, terminology, musicality, choreography, and classroom discipline for dancers ready to advance. Ages 4-5

Pre-Jazz:

An energetic introduction to jazz technique, rhythm, movement quality, and choreography through upbeat music and engaging activities. Ages 4-5

Ballet:

A disciplined, technical art form developing strength, alignment, grace, musicality, and precision. Students train across a range of Vaganova, Cecchetti, and Balanchine-based techniques while building a strong foundation for all dance styles.

Pointe/Pre-Pointe:

Advanced ballet training focused on developing the strength, alignment, and technical proficiency required for safe pointe work. With approval. Minimum technique class requirements.

Contemporary/Modern:

A versatile performance-based style blending ballet, modern, improvisation, partnering, and contemporary movement techniques.

Jazz/Musical Theatre:

Dynamic theatrical training emphasizing style, musicality, performance quality, body alignment, and Broadway-inspired movement.

Acro:

Technique-focused acrobatic training that builds flexibility, strength, balance, control, coordination, and confidence.

Hip Hop/Street:

High-energy training in hip hop foundations, musicality, isolations, freestyle, and performance-driven choreography.

Competition Teams:

Elite performance teams offering dedicated dancers expanded training, convention and competition experience, pro-level and community performance opportunities, teamwork, and artistic growth. Out of state travel every other year, 3-5 competitions annually, plus film and photography opportunities.

DRESS CODES:

Required so that instructors can see student alignment and make technical corrections. We have some items; please stop in or order online early! We recommend purchasing locally from **Allegra & Co.** in Anchorage, or **Beyond the Barre** in the Valley.

Parent & Me: any style dance or active wear. Fitted clothing welcome. Bare feet welcome. Please have hair secured away from face. Always bring a sippy cup or water bottle.

Creative Movement: any style dance or active wear. Fitted clothing welcome. Ballet slippers. Please have hair secured away from face. Always bring a sippy cup or water bottle.

Pre-Ballet: any style soft pink leotard, full sole pink tights, full sole leather slippers. Hair must be neatly secured away from face. Always bring a water bottle.

Level 1: any style light lavender leotard, convertible ballet pink tights, pink full sole leather slippers. Black jazz pants. Hair must be in a neat bun or braid. Always bring a water bottle.

Level 2: any style burgundy leotard, convertible ballet pink tights, pink split sole canvas slippers. Black dance pants. Hair must be in a neat bun or braid. Always bring a water bottle.

Level 3: any style light/soft blue leotard, convertible ballet pink tights, pink split sole canvas slippers. Please note that sports bras and briefs are not worn under leotards; tights are considered the undergarment. Hair must be in a neat bun.

Level 4: any style midnight blue/navy leotard, convertible backseam tights, pink split sole canvas slippers. Dance-specific warm ups are OK while at the barre. Pointe fittings upon instructor approval. Please note that sports bras and briefs are not worn under leotards; tights are considered the undergarment. Hair must be in a neat bun.

Level 5: any style all-black leotard, convertible backseam tights, pink split sole canvas slippers. Dance-specific warm ups are OK while at the barre. Pointe fittings upon instructor approval. Sports bras and briefs are not worn under leotards; tights are considered the undergarment. Hair must be in a neat bun.

Level 6: Any color, any style leotard! Convertible backseam tights, pink split sole canvas slippers. Dance-specific warm ups are OK while at the barre. Pointe fittings upon instructor approval. Sports bras and briefs are not worn under leotards; tights are considered the undergarment. Hair must be in a neat bun.

All Levels - Contemporary or Jazz: Class leotard worn with all-black dance leggings. Please - no sloppy flannels or sweatpants! Half-sole lyrical slippers (called "pirouettes") suggested. Jazz classes require black or nude jazz shoes or character shoes depending on dancer age and instructor preference. Hair must be neatly pulled back in ponytail, braid or bun.

Acro/Tumbling: Gymnastics onesie or ballet leotard with fitted black dance leggings or shorts. Bare feet. Hair must be neatly pulled back and flat against the head, ideally braided or in a low bun.

Boys' Dress Code: Fitted white t-shirt. Transition/convertible black dance tights or black leggings. Black ballet slippers, bare feet or jazz shoes (depending on class). Boys ages 12+ must wear a dance belt. Always bring a water bottle.

Hip Hop: Any comfortable clothing. Indoor sneakers are a must; no outdoor shoes are permitted.



★ **IMPORTANT POLICIES & withdrawal process – please read!** ★

REGISTRATION: A student's spot in class is not reserved until their first month's tuition and registration fee have been paid. Monthly tuition accounts for longer months and holiday closures and is prorated for simplicity; this means that tuition payments remain the same monthly, regardless of closures or extra classes.

TUITION PAYMENTS: Tuition is due the first of the month via auto pay. Avoid processing fees by paying with check or cash! Our small business appreciates checks to avoid credit card fees. For your convenience, auto pay is available with a \$4 processing fee, and will be processed the first day of every month through May.

PRODUCTION FEES: Production fees cover dancers' costume(s), shipping, and additional recital costs. Recital tickets aid in performance venue rental, additional rehearsals and staffing, and *much* more. **Production fees are due no later than November 24th for every performing class and are non-refundable.** Fees are accepted any time before the due date. *We can't guarantee late paid costumes will still be available or arrive in time for recital.*

LATE & INSUFFICIENT FUNDS FEES: A late fee of \$25 is automatically applied to past due accounts and past due production fees by the 10th of the month. **A \$25 late/administrative fee is applied to bounced checks and declined auto pays.**

UNPAID ACCOUNTS: Students with a past due account will be unable to participate in further classes, competitions, or year-end recital until their account is brought current.

CLOSURES: Studio Pulse follows ASD holiday and most weather closures only as a guideline. Classes still run on most in-service days. In case of emergency/weather closures, we will send an email and post on the Studio Pulse Center for Dance Facebook page by noon.

ATTENDANCE: The studio opens 20 minutes prior to the first class of the day, and dancers must be dressed and ready by class start time. Regular attendance is important, and being present for class warm up is required for dancer safety. When a dancer misses classes or is perpetually tardy, both the dancer and the class fall behind.



WITHDRAWAL: To officially withdraw a student from class(es) and to end continued tuition charges, email StudioPulseAK@gmail.com with notice of withdrawal two weeks prior to the first of the month. Any students withdrawing and returning later in the year will incur a \$25 administrative fee. *Studio Pulse is unable to hold a spot for students who leave for extended periods of time (vacations, sports) but who do not continue paying tuition.*

MAKE-UP CLASSES: Make-up classes are provided as a courtesy, but we can not provide tuition adjustments for missed classes. Tuition reserves your child's spot in class.

COMMUNICATION: Important information will be emailed throughout the year. General information is also posted on our website, the Studio Pulse Center for Dance Facebook page, and @PulseDanceAK Instagram. Please email StudioPulseAK@gmail.com with questions - we can't guarantee a timely response on social media.

STUDENT PICK UP: If your dancer is under the age of 10, please arrive at studio doors for pickup. Children may NOT exit alone or run into the parking lot unattended.

STUDIO RULES & ETIQUETTE:

- Seats for class viewing are limited. To keep hallways clear and for ongoing health precautions, we are unable to accommodate multiple family members per dancer in our waiting areas. Student drop off is encouraged for ages 7+. Please - no running, jumping, or yelling in the facility. Thank you for your help!
- Remove shoes when entering the facility so that floors remain clean and dry for students.
- **NO food or beverages** other than water permitted in the lounge areas.
- Dressing rooms are furnished with cubbies and coat hooks so that students can neatly store their belongings out of main traffic areas. Please tuck bags away from traffic areas.
- We value our off-screen time and meaningful human interactions. We ask that dancers' cell phones be silenced and put away while in our facility, and smart watches removed or set to "do not disturb" or airplane mode. We want to encourage interaction and real relationships!
